What is modern slavery?

Modern slavery is when an individual is **exploited by others, for personal or commercial gain**. Modern slavery can include human trafficking, forced labour and sexual exploitation.

It's often hidden in plain sight, and it's estimated that more than **130,000 people are trapped in modern slavery** in the UK today.

What does Snowdrop do?

We provide holistic, long-term, community-based support to survivors so that they can reach a place of independence. Our approach covers all key support needs, including independent living, physical and mental wellbeing, community engagement, education and employment.
